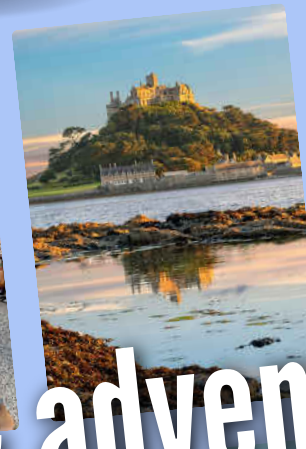




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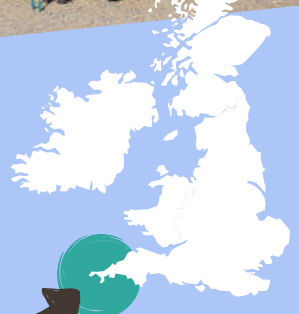

Welcome to Falmouth!

River Cruise from Falmouth to Truro

The River Fal is a beautiful tidal estuary that connects the historic towns of Falmouth with its long maritime history and Truro, the capital of Cornwall with its fine cathedral and Georgian city centre.



To introduce you to Cornwall, we love to take you on the tranquil river cruise that links these two towns. It takes just under an hour to cruise up to Truro with an interesting audio tour of historic sites along the estuary.



On arrival in Truro, we provide the option for a guided tour with us around the cathedral and the Royal Cornwall Museum – or you can explore the town independently. Then, we will all meet up for a cream tea before returning to Falmouth.



Tintagel Castle & King Arthur

One of the most famous legends from Cornwall is the story of King Arthur. After learning about King Arthur's connection to Cornwall in class, we will head off to the amazing castle where King Arthur was born in Tintagel.

The location is spectacular with a wonderful new bridge connecting the mainland to the castle. Of course, there will also be time to explore the ancient, magical town of Tintagel to buy some special King Arthur souvenirs too.



Cornwall's Great Gardens

No trip to Cornwall would be complete without visiting at least one of its historic English country gardens. For anyone who loves flowers, plants and trees, these gardens are home to the most wonderful array of plants and flowers from around the world.

Most of the houses and gardens in Cornwall were built by people from Cornwall who had made their fortune from the tin and copper mining industry at the start of the Industrial Revolution. While nowadays people might buy super yachts to display their wealth, in the Victorian era, the fashion was to create the most spectacular gardens using plants imported from around the world.

The main focus will be on natural, spoken English and students will get to learn lots about the history and culture of Cornwall with lessons closely linked to the excursion programme.



Watersports

Cornwall is surrounded by the sea with hundreds of fantastic beaches to choose from!

For those adults interested in spending more time being in the ocean during their time in Cornwall, we can provide additional watersports sessions during the week. Just let us know if you would like our extra watersports option on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. It is completely flexible, and you are welcome to choose how many watersports sessions you would like.

All the watersports we offer are delivered by our expert partners with their teams of staff who love getting people in the water around Cornwall.

Even if you have never tried these sports before, Cornwall is the perfect place to try them for the first time. We work with some brilliant organisations who will ensure you are completely safe in the water and that everyone has a great experience!





Tour of St Michael's Mount & Marazion

The trip to St Michael's Mount is a guaranteed student favourite. We always make sure we take you at the perfect time so you get to experience the changing tides. At low tide you can walk across to the island but then, when the tide comes in, the only way to the island is by boat.

For those students who like an extra challenge, it is great fun to walk back to the mainland just as the tide is coming in!

After enjoying the guided tour of the castle, there is always time for an ice-cream in the garden and a stroll around the pretty village of Marazion.



The Eden Project

Since opening in 2001, the Eden Project has become a world-famous tourist attraction.

The huge biomes that house the Eden Project are among the biggest in the world and it is such an amazing place to learn about the importance of preserving our plant biodiversity around the world.

The Minack Theatre & Porthcurno

Our afternoon and evening excursion to the Minack Theatre is always one of the highlights of our summer programme. The Minack is a spectacular outdoor theatre carved into the cliff.

We will arrive in the afternoon to enjoy some time on Porthcurno beach and a little coast walk before climbing the cliff for the evening performance.

Falmouth University Campus

Falmouth University is one of the best universities in the UK for the Creative Arts.

The local population of Falmouth & Penryn is around 35,000. It is a beautiful location at the mouth of the Fal Estuary which is world-famous for sailing and watersports.

The harbour towns of Falmouth and Penryn are lively student towns and there is always lots going on, plus there are three different beaches to enjoy around the two towns.



Accommodation & classrooms



All the classrooms, accommodation, dining and leisure facilities are located on the same campus and everything is within a few minutes' walk.

The accommodation has been designed as a student village. There are lots of trees and gardens and it is just a short walk from the accommodation to the main teaching buildings.

The modern accommodation is provided in flats with 7 bedrooms in each flat. Each student will have a private room with en-suite bathroom. And each flat has a shared living room and kitchen for students to use (please see the floor plan on the next page).

In each accommodation block, there are four floors with 7 flats on each floor. Each floor and the whole accommodation block is protected by security doors that require a key code. Students will have keys for their own rooms. Males and females will be accommodated in separate flats.



Our staff and the university security team are available and on-site 24 hours per day.

Dining Room & Food

All the food is freshly prepared on site by the university catering team. Each day the students will have: a buffet breakfast, a cooked lunch and evening meal in the university dining hall.

In the mornings there will be a buffet service with both continental and cooked breakfast options. Students can choose from cereals, toast and pastries alongside an English cooked breakfast.

At lunchtimes, there are a wide variety of cooked and salad options to choose from. Everyone gets a main meal, drink and desert.

Similarly in the evenings, there will always be hot meals with a selection of options to choose from. All meals are prepared freshly on site to ensure our students can enjoy healthy meals with options to suit all dietary needs.

Evenings with Language Tree

Falmouth & Truro are great towns to enjoy in the evenings. They both have some great restaurants, there is the Hall for Cornwall in Truro (theatre shows), cinemas and live music events.

We organise some evening events and we are happy to signpost students to things they would like to do independently.





Host family accommodation

Our host families are a key part of our overall programme. If you choose this type of accommodation, we try to make sure we place you with the best host family suited to your needs and interests.

Before joining your course in the UK, we will have matched you to your host family and we put you in touch with them to exchange an initial greeting before your arrival.

When you arrive in Cornwall, your host family will be ready to meet you and help you feel settled and relaxed from the moment you arrive.

We are proud to say we know all our host families personally. We inspect all our accommodation every year and all our host families have full DBS (UK police) checks.



We also know our host families are really interested in welcoming international students to come and stay in their house and to introduce them to an English cultural experience.

As part of staying with a host family, you will receive full board accommodation.

You will have breakfast and evening meals with your host family and a cooked lunch on campus together with all the students before heading off on the afternoon excursions and activities.

You will be matched to a host family who can cater for any dietary needs you may have.

As well as the activity and excursion programme you will enjoy with Language Tree, your host family may well also have some little activities for you to enjoy with them too.



Private accommodation



As well as providing accommodation options organised by us, we are also happy to assist you to find the perfect apartment, house or cottage for your stay in Cornwall if you would prefer this type of accommodation.

We know the local area well and we can send you a variety of accommodation options that you can then book direct with the accommodation provider.
